It has turned to ash



His ministry is enhanced by his secular professional experiences as a Social Worker, Fire Fighter, Emergency Medical Technician, Deputy Sheriff, business owner and lapidary artist; and his 40+ years of recovery from heroin addiction and alcoholism.

Rev. Rafe is a life-long spiritually motivated social activist. He has served as a security lead for Rhythm Fest, Southern Womyn's Music and Comedy Festival, and the 1993 March on Washington for LGBTQ Rights. He has served on the PFLAG Speakers Bureau in numerous states and was an active member of Interfaith Nevada County speaking at several Black Lives Matter events and co-facilitating a Memorial Service honoring the lives of Nevada County residents lost to COVID (8' 2018 thru 2' 2023). He is already connected with

Howard County Clergy Alliance and recently spoken on a panel of LBGTQIA+ Faith Based Leaders at the Owen Brown Interfaith Center.

Rev. Rafe has been an active member of the Centers for Spiritual Living since 2003. He has served as a Licensed Practitioner since 2008 and as a Licensed Minister since 2017.
